FCA Summer Day Camp Information

FCA Summer Camp is for campers fully potty-trained and age 3 by May 1st of this year through campers who are 10 before or on May 1st of this year.

How to enroll:

- **Print, complete and return application to Faith Christian Academy with payment for 1st week's attendance. Applications should be given to Ms Sharon Wallace, FCA Summer Camp Director.** Enrollment is "First Turned In, First Accepted". Spaces are limited and offered to FCA students and previous campers first.
- **The initial weekly fee must be paid to hold a camper's first week. Additional weeks must be paid by 3:00 pm on the Friday before camp begins on Monday.** If this fee is not paid, the spot will become available for someone on the waiting list and your camper will lose his/her spot for the week. The additional weeks your camper has signed up for will follow the same rules of having to be paid for by 3:00 pm the Friday before camp begins on Monday. Once your specified week has been paid, you can not transfer to another week! (No partial weeks, No Refunds)
- **Immunization form, birth certificate, and Social Security card must be turned in before the camper may attend.** If your child is a student at FCA, we should already have those forms.

Additional information and rules:

--Drop off starts at 7:30 am. Camp begins at 8:00 am. Pick up time ends at 5:15 pm. A late fee of \$1 per minute per child will be charged after 5:15pm camp time.

--Due to DSS regulations, sunscreen must be applied at home prior to attending camp.

--Regular clothes should be worn on Splash Fridays with swimsuits, t-shirts, & towels brought for later in the day.

--No electronics/phones are allowed at camp.

--Campers 3 through 6 years old must bring an extra set of clothes to stay at camp in case of spills or potty accidents.

--Campers 5K and up may bring a board game to share during game time.

--Parents will provide child's snacks (2) and lunch daily. A water bottle must be sent daily.

--Preschool campers will need a nap mat, mat cover and in a bag to be brought to camp on Mondays and sent home on Fridays to be cleaned.

FCA Summer Camp Dress Code

- 1. Clothing that compromises modesty because of tightness, sheerness, or length is inappropriate.**

No holes in clothes. Patched clothing is acceptable.

See-through shirts, halter-tops, or outfits with cut-outs exposing the middle torso (midriff type) are NOT permitted. Necklines should not be lower than a closed hand width below collar bone. No bra straps should be visible.

Shorts or skirts may be no shorter than mid-thigh. (To determine appropriate length: have the student stand with arms at his/her side and hands extended, if fingers touch skin, then the shorts are too short.)

Pants should fit properly at the natural waistline (no sagging or excessively baggy or tight pants) and belts should be worn when pants have belt loops. No undergarments should be visible. Girls should wear shorts under their dresses.

- 2. Words and pictures on clothing must not be demeaning to our Lord or contradict the principles and values of Christianity. Messages written across the seats (fanny) of clothing are not acceptable. New Age, gang, or alcohol related symbols on clothing or jewelry are not allowed.**
- 3. For safety, shoes should be able to stay on feet when running. Sandals need straps that secure shoes onto feet. Crocs will not be considered acceptable if they do not secure onto feet.**
- 4. If a camper has vomited or run a fever of 99.5 or higher, they should remain home until 24 hours has passed from the time there is no longer a fever or vomiting. This is to protect other campers and staff from illness. (“Do to others as you would have them do to you.” Luke 6:31)**
- 5. Swimsuits: Everyone must wear a shirt over their swimsuit. No one may wear bikini swimsuits. Girls: Shirts must be worn over swimsuits. Tankinis (top and bottom overlap) or one-piece swimsuits are acceptable. No “French Cut” or “Boy Cut” bottoms where buttocks show are allowed. Boys: Shirts must be worn with swim trunks.**
